Korntal offers various academic programmes for cross-cultural workers:

- Bachelor of Arts in Culture & Theology.

It is a flexible, competence-oriented and experience-integrated study programme. At the core lies theological and intercultural competence. Cornerstone studies and studies from other ICETE accredited theological schools are accepted as transfer credit. Portions of the studies can be conducted in the host country or covered through distance learning or onlineoffers. Language and culture studies may be credited under specified conditions. A minimum of 32 credits hours (25% of the 126 cr/h) have to be earned through AWM Korntal /CIU. In North America the degree is accredited through ATS, SACS and ABHE as part of Columbia International University's degree offerings. Entrance into the study program is possible at any time.

Within the framework of its cross cultural mission training Redcliffe offers different mission related M.A. options. All those degree programmes are accredited by the University of Gloucestershire.

Cornerstone graduates who already have a B.A. degree from their previous training can go directly into one of those M.A. programmes if they are able to meet the specific course-related entry requirements.

Applications will be looked at on a case-by-case basis. The M.A. studies are done through intensive delivery mode, normally over 3 weeks in May or in periodic long-weekends, and involve a significant amount of self-directed study.

The purpose of All Nations Christian College is to train and equip men and women for effective participation in God's mission in His multicultural world. The College offers both BA (Hons) and MA degress accredited by the Open University.











BA (Hons): the BA is aimed at those who are preparing for long- term crosscultural mission service and who appreciate the balance of practical and academic study. The training is consciously holistic and vocational, and is focused around four main educational aims: (1) spiritual maturity and personal development, (2) biblical and theological understanding, (3) cross-cultural engagement, and (4) relevant ministry and practical skills. All Nations keep academic excellence and spiritual formation at the centre of its training.

Within its Undergraduate Programme, All Nations offers a 3 year BA (Hons) in Biblical and Intercultural Studies. Those who have a prior degree in any subjects, can complete the BA (Hons) in two years and in some cases in one year. The first year of study is the foundational Certificate programme. The second year of study is the Diploma programme. In the final year of study students can benefit from choosing from a range of modules such as Leadership, Planting and Development of the Church, Religion and society, Johannine Literature, New Testament Theology, Old Testament Theology, Holistic Community Practice, Managing Holistic Community Programmes, Contemporary Islam, a Biblical language option, specialist arts modules, Advanced Mission Studies, and a Research Paper in your chosen area of mission.

- MA programme: the MA in Contemporary Mission Studies was the first to be taught in the UK and has attracted Christian leaders from around the world. It is aimed at those who would like to gain a deeper understanding of the range of issues within the discipline of mission studies: its biblical, theological, historical, cultural and religious dimensions. Students will gain a wide grasp of current thinking, trends and developments in global Christianity and will sharpen their missiological understanding of the Bible. The programme is especially suitable for those who have some years of Christian ministry experience in contextual theology, leadership or development work. It can be done either residentially or online. Exit awards are:
